As you enter, you are greeted by a light-drenched atrium. "I wanted high volumes and big, flowing open spaces," the owner explains. The exposed ceiling has almost cathedral-like qualities, with a steep pitch and intricate truss detailing. In contrast, the cutting-edge floating staircase and feature raw-concrete wall offer a striking, modern flavour.


From the spacious entrance, four steps lead you down into the main hub of the house. At night, these are lit from under each tread, the glow spreading warmth across the floors.

The kitchen has been designed for simplistic elegance. The white countertops reflect the natural light coming through the low-level window, while the oak wall units are a natural touch that balances out the cool colour palette throughout the house. >



"I wanted to reduce the number of indoor dining/lounge areas by using the big sliding doors, which, when opened, convert the lounge and dining rooms into 'outside' areas," the home owner adds. This style of living makes a lot of sense in the tropical climes of Durban, especially when you have such beautiful views.

One area of interest is the concealed TV "snug". Hidden behind corner pocket doors, this modest-sized room allows

for privacy or somewhere to cosy up in winter.

In the upper-highway area of KwaZulu-Natal, the temperature can drop dramatically at night, so the owner has opted for built-in wood burners. Deliberately offset and with no embellishments, they reinforce the minimalist influence of this home, further evidence of which comes in the form of uncluttered room layouts.

practical yet elegant materials. The dark-brown leather couch and burnt-amber wall tiles in the lounge establish a sense of warmth, while the stark contrast between the grey tones of the concrete-looking floor tiles and walls and the crisp black aluminium glass doors bring style and elegance, framing and focusing the eye on the views beyond.

"My intention was to create an entertainer's delight, where entertainment can take place as easily around the kitchen island as at the dining-room table, or outside around the pool," the owner says.
